Regulations Governing the Jiang-Shiou Hwang Scholarship

Approved at the third Department Affairs Council meeting on December 16, 2015

Approved at the first Department Affairs Council meeting on September 19, 2018

1. Establishment:

To reward graduate students from the biology division of the Department of Oceanography (hereinafter “the Department”), National Sun Yat-Sen University, Professor Jiang-Shiou Hwang has established the Marine Biology Research Scholarship (hereinafter “the Scholarship”) with a prize of NT\$12,000 per year.

2. Recipients:

Graduate students from the biology division with proactive attitudes and good moral character.

3. Scholarship quota and amount:

The Scholarship is offered to two individuals, with each receiving NT\$12,000.

4. Eligibility:

Graduate students from the biology division of the Department are eligible to apply. Candidates from low-income families or with an interest in and exceptional talent for marine biology research are prioritized.

5. Application process:

Applicants shall provide the following documents for a review:

- (1) application form,
- (2) undergraduate and graduate transcripts from the National Sun Yat-Sen University or other universities, and
- (3) documents relevant to the applicant’s scholarship review, such as research reports, published papers, certificates of awards, and personal resumes.

6. Application date:

The applicant must submit an application within one month after the academic year commences (in late October every year) and prior to the specified deadline; the actual date will be announced later.

7. Application review:

Applications shall be reviewed by the Academic Committee of the Department.

8. These regulations become effective upon approval by a Department Affairs Council meeting. Amendments must follow the same procedure.
